

Fire Cleanup Tips & Guidelines

Hazardous Waste Alert & Handling

Household Hazardous Waste such as liquid paint, partially full aerosol cans or propane tanks and so on cannot be taken to a transfer station or landfill. These materials are acceptable at the Community Hazardous Waste Collection Center. Please call 805-882-3602 for information on the center.

For other questions regarding the disposal of Household Hazardous Waste, please contact the Public Health Department during normal business hours at 805-346-8460.

Obtain a Demolition Permit

After the hazardous materials have been removed from your property, the next step is to obtain a demolition permit. To do so contact the Building & Safety Division of the Department of Planning and Development, at (805) 558-3030.

Cleanup Safety

During actual cleanup of fire debris, keep materials damp to limit the amount of dust and ash in the air. Wear protective gear including face masks, eye protection, long sleeves, pants and gloves. Damaged Vehicle Removal

Most cars can be hauled away by a towing company. If you have problems with removing a vehicle, call (805) 681-4342.

Fire Debris Removal

After getting a demolition permit, material can be hauled by a permitted hauler or a licensed contractor to the facilities listed below in lined and covered containers. The material should be fully contained in a tarp or plastic - the "Burrito Wrap" method.
